Basic Environmental Philosophy

The SAPTI Inc. Tsukuba Factory, in undertaking our principal business of silk screen printing, engages in conscientious company activities in the continual aim to be a company that is trusted by society, and in full recognition of the importance of the natural environment, we implement measures to prevent waste of resources, work to minimize our impact on the environment in which society exists, and conduct our activities that create value to be passed on to future generations.

Environmental Policy

This environmental policy is formed to incorporate the following promises.

1. In managing our business, we will create and operate an environmental management system based on ISO 14001, and continually improve the environmental impact of the business activities, products, and services of the Tsukuba Factory.
2. We will establish frameworks for setting environmental goals.
3. We will work to prevent pollution, use sustainable resources whenever possible in conducting our business, and implement measures to address and alleviate climate change, and will participate with other companies in the vicinity in the area in cleanups and other environmentally related community activities in the endeavor to protect biodiversity and ecosystems.
4. We will comply with laws, regulations, and the requirements of the company's stakeholders that we have accepted.
5. To improve our environmental performance, we will set objectives and goals for the initiatives below, promote improvement activities on a continuous basis, and review all activities based on the results of internal environmental audits.
